To make a cup of coffee: As soon as the coffee is parched, scarcely brown, grind as much as you will want to use for that time; put in the coffee pot, and pour on boiling water; stir, place it on the fire, bring it to a boil; as soon as four or five bubbles appear, take it off the fire, pour out a tea-cupful and return it, then put the pot down over a small fire, and let it stand for one minute, then pour out another tea-cupful, and so on, until you have made another minute to allow the heavy cold water to sink to the bottom and carry the grounds with it; then put your usual amount of sugar in your coffee-cup, and as much boiling milk as you desire, then fill it from your coffee-pot.

NEW HARVESTING MACHINE.—A machine for harvesting corn, by taking the ears from the stalk while standing in the field, was exhibited at the recent State Fair in Illinois. The apparatus is constructed to strip two rows at once. The stalks are taken by projecting metal fingers, but the machine does not cut the ears, but merely brings them in contact with a short spike, playing at the rear of the fingers, cutting it off, while the stalk passes under the machine without being pulled up; the ears are received into a large hopper at the end of the machine, and discharged when it falls.

VENTILATION AND LIGHT.—In the last excellent report of the Superintendent of Public Schools, we find the following: "Within a few years past millions of dollars have been expended in furnishing accommodations for public schools, with scarcely any reference to the two most important requisites for the comfort and health of the pupils—pure air and uniform degrees of light. In most of the school rooms throughout New England, either the teachers or the pupils are compelled to sit facing the strong light from windows directly opposite to their seats. This arrangement is to be deprecated as pernicious in the extreme. The injuries that scholars suffer from either an excess of deficiency of light, are very generally permanent and incurable. In consequence of too little light pupils often become shortsighted, and round-shouldered by bringing the head near the book. And when there is an excess of light, their visual organs are very seriously impaired."

WHY DO THEY DIE. The Times of recent date, records the death of a laboring man named Richard Jones, who, according to apparently sufficient evidence, had attained the age of 112 years. The patriarchal length of days, although rare, is not unprecedented even in comparatively modern times. Henry Jenkins is said to have lived 169 years. He was born in the reign of Henry VII. When a boy he took a cartload of arrows to the English army at Floden Field, and lived to relate the circumstances in the reign of Charles VIII. Thomas Parr, known as "Old Parr," died at the age of 152, and enjoyed the posthumous distinction of being dissected by Harvey. Jean Claude Jacob, a serf from the Jura Mountains, appeared before the National Assembly in 1792, at the time of the first Revolution, and was 92 years old. There is said to have been an inhabitant of the island of St. Helena, in the month of August, 1820, who was 110 years of age. One of the oldest men who died at a late age was a Frenchman who lived to the age of 100, and arrived at the centenary of his birth in the month of April, 1850. Many other instances of similar longevity might be mentioned. But though in a series of generations it is easy to find that a considerable number of persons have survived 100 years, yet, in any one generation, it is almost impossible to find more than one or two persons who have attained to the age of 100 years.
