or liquid matter, inhaled in a vaporous atmosphere. Overlying this was a spectrum consisting of four bright lines. This plainly proved the existence of a second source of light, showing by its spectrum to be luminous. Two of these lines were the prominent hydrogen lines, and their great brightness showed the gas to be hotter than the phosphorescence. The condenser was obvious—the object being a bluish vapor of hydrogen gas, which was being heated by the sudden flash of the electric arc.

The Scientific American gives the following mode of testing kerosene: Fill a cup with warm water; the temperature of which is to be brought to the boiling point of water; pour the oil on the water; apply flame to the floating oil by match or otherwise. If the oil is unsafe it will take fire, and its use is dangerous, for it is liable to explode. But if the oil is safe and good, it will not take fire.
