The necessity for the continued prosperity of the Friberg mine has been worked for about seven centuries, may be gathered from the fact that at the present time there are more than 6,000 laborers, with their families, amounting altogether to some 20,000 persons, who derive sustenance from the mines and metallurgical works connected with them.

THE EASTERN WAR. The reports of the last week indicate active service, but without any decisive result. The following are the principal dispatches: BERLIN, Oct. 5.—The Russians officially acknowledge a loss of fifty-two thousand men to September 27th.

LONDON, Oct. 5.—Particulars of the battle before Kars make it evident that the Russians assaulted the Turkish positions along the whole line, and were repulsed with heavy loss. The successes gained on Tuesday in the capture of the great Yazi Hill, did not compensate for the failure at other points.

VIENNA, Oct. 5.—The Montenegrins have abandoned hostilities in Herzegovina, because the territory they now hold on that side corresponds with the line of demarcation made and accepted in the preliminary conference at Gosanzk. It is not likely that the Montenegrins will be more in the final settlement which must be made by Europe.

CONSTANTINOPLE, Oct. 7.—Moukhtar Pasha telegraphs Friday: Today, the bulk of the Russian forces struck the foot of the Karadagh, leaving only six battalions entrenched at Kabak. They have thus abandoned their positions parallel with our lines.

THE INDIANS.—The prospects of a speedy permanent peace with the Indians is far from promising. Under date of Oct. 3d, the Herald's Montana special says: "General Howard has determined to follow the Indians to the bitter end."

SITTING BULL.—There begins to be a question about the identity of the famous Sioux chief, Sitting Bull. One report says: "The mystery that has hitherto surrounded the person of the great Sioux warrior, Sitting Bull, has been removed."

VIOLANO IN THE COLORADO DESERT.—The San Francisco Alto says that several telegrams from Los Angeles have announced the breaking out of a volcano in the Colorado desert, sixty miles this side of Fort Yuma.

FROM ALASKA.—A Portland, Oregon, dispatch of Sept. 24th, says: "An army chaplain from Sitka, reports a deplorable condition of affairs there, since the withdrawal of the troops."

THE STORM OF Thursday night, Oct. 4th, caused serious damage shipping along the North Atlantic coast, and to railroads, from the washing of swollen streams.
