A portion of the party, consisting of two men, and the agent, four women and several boys and girls, while on the streets, were surrounded by a crowd of 150, mostly men. A young boy was struck on the face, and the child's teeth were loosened. The party separated and ran in different directions, which broke the crowd. Much indignation is expressed, but no arrests have yet been made.

The net proceeds of the confiscations and sale of the church property, amounting to about \$100,000,000, are being distributed to the poor.
